CHRISTMAS NEWSLETTER

11 Corinthians 5:17; "If anyone is in Christ there is a new creation: everything old has past away; see, everything has become new!" In Christ we have been changed. We grow in our faith through the Word and Sacraments and fellowship with like-minded brothers and sisters in Christ.

Every day is a new beginning for our mission to the world. We know that we are sinners in need of redeeming. What is this mission that Jesus calls us to proclaim? That He was crucified on the cross and rose again from the dead. We are called to share with the world what he has done for us. (Colossians 1:20) In Jesus the fullness of God was pleased to dwell. God was pleased to reconcile to himself all things through the blood of His cross.

<u>Deuteronomy 21:22-23</u> according to the Jewish Law, all who are hung on a tree is cursed by God. Jesus was not cursed by God, our sins were cursed. Our souls have been washed by the blood of the Lamb. The Lamb washed our souls white as snow, freshly fallen snow. His love snatched our souls from the evil one. We are cleansed by the washing of the Lamb.


Council would like the membership to be aware of our financial status on a month to month basis. Below is where we are at after the Tenth month of 2023.

Ascension's 150th Anniversary

Throughout the year we will have information in the newsletter about our history and also old articles on our bulletins boards. We also want to highlight the many benevolences we support by featuring them during the worship service on a monthly basis. We plan on having the youth and any adult members sing for shut-ins sometime in the Spring of the year so watch the announcements for that. In October during the Polka service we want to hold a reunion Sunday and invite all past and present members to attend. Since our church was officially organized on November 26, 1874 we plan to hold a special worship service on November 3rd and invite back all our past pastors. There will also be a dinner after the service with historical pictures to view. We also plan to have a memento of our 150th anniversary available for purchase. This is just an overview of the plans with more details to follow as we get closer to 2024.

1874 Ascension Anniversary Calendar of Events 2024

February – A mementos will be available for purchase.

April – Sing to the shut-in. Young and old in heart are welcome to come and sing. More info when we are closer to the date.

September—Will have a Remembrance Sunday where we will show videos of past years after the worship service.

October – Will be having a Polka service and a reunion Sunday. Will be inviting past & present members with a fellowship after service.

November – November 26, 1874 our church was officially organized. We will have a special worship service on November 3, 2024. We are inviting past pastors to join us. A chicken dinner will be served after the service to celebrate 150 years.

Other projects that will be happening during the year:

We have asked all the Benevolences we support through-out the year to come and tell us how our financial support benefits them.

In the visitor we be putting some in some "Way Back When" articles every month.

The bulletin boards will be changed every month with different pictures and articles from the past.





Second Anna Club Nursing Home Ministry

A year ago, a nursing home director reached out to me, "Can you start an Anna Club in my nursing home?" It felt like a Macedonian Call (Acts 16:9). My heart leapt at the possibility but at the time no one on my team was willing to take on an additional commitment.

My heart was broken. As I was praying I suddenly understood Jesus exhortation to His disciples, "the harvest is plentiful but the workers are few." My heart was ready to leap but I had no one to help. I had done everything possible. IHOPKC had opened many doors to me to share: I pulled people aside, cast the vision over and over etc etc, but still there was no one to help. I realized there really was only one thing left to do: "Therefore pray to the Lord of the harvest that He would send forth laborers." I began to cry out to God, "Jesus, please stir hearts for the elderly! And please stir hearts to help me fight abortion." (I was in the throws of recruiting actors for my short film at the same time.)

Sure enough after several weeks of prayer, God began to stir hearts both to act in my music video and for the nursing home! A staff member of IHOPKC approached me saying, "God has told me to make the ministry of Anna Club the priority of my schedule above anything else." Wow!! God did it! I thought to myself, "It is so much better when God brings me leaders than me recruiting."

So, two months ago, we began our second Anna Club at Luthern nursing home in Kansas! It is so incredible being in an atmosphere were most of the staff are believers and want us to preach the Gospel!

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Sloppy Joes

2 LBS GROUND BEEF 1/2 CUP ONION, DICED 1/2 CUP GREEN PEPPER, DICED 1 TSP GARLIC POWDER 2 TSP YELLOW MUSTARD 1 1/2 CUP KETCHUP 2 TBSP BROWN SUGAR SALT AND PEPPER TO TASTE



In a skillet over medium heat, brown the ground beef, onion and green pepper; drain off liq-

uids.

Stir in the garlic powder, mustard, ketchup and brown sugar; Mix thoroughly. Reduce heat and simmer for 30 minutes. Season to taste with salt and pepper.
