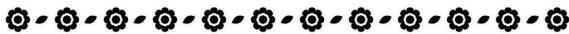

Collection for April 2026 Flood Victims



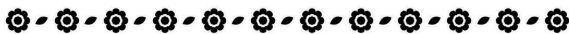
We are accepting monetary donations for the flood victims through July 31 2026.

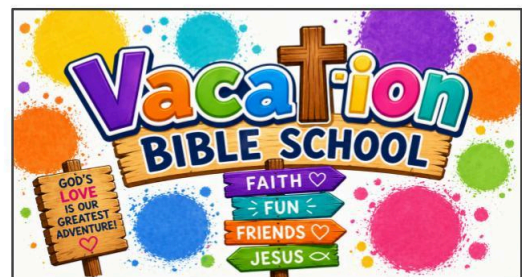
