Welcome and Explanation of the evening's worship including imposition of ashes and communion.

Opening Reading *Psalm 51:1-13 (page 239 in your green hymnal or on the screen)*

L: Have mercy on me, O God, according to your lovingkindness;

C: in your great compassion blot out my offenses.

L: Wash me through and through from my wickedness,

C: and cleanse me from my sin.

L: For I know my transgressions,

C: and my sin is ever before me.

L: Against you only have I sinned

C: and done what is evil in your sight.

L: And so you are justified when you speak

C: and upright in your judgment.

L: Indeed, I have been wicked from my birth,

C: a sinner from my mother's womb.

L: For behold, you look for truth deep within me,

C: and will make me understand wisdom secretly.

L: Purge me from my sin, and I shall be pure;

C: wash me, and I shall be clean indeed.

L: Make me hear of joy and gladness,

C: that the body you have broken may rejoice.

L: Hide your face from my sins,

C: and blot out all my iniquities.

L: Create in me a clean heart, O God,

C: and renew a right spirit within me.

L: Cast me not away from your presence,

C: and take not your Holy Spirit from me.

L: Give me the joy of your saving help again,

C: and sustain me with your bountiful Spirit.

P: In this holy season the Son of God humbles himself so that we receive mercy.

C: Humble me once again, O God, that my life would be pleasing and acceptable to you.

P: In this holy season the Son of God prays for us so that we are made one with him and each other.

C: Help me to faithfully pray, O God, that my prayers would be pleasing and acceptable to you.

P: In this holy season the Son of God lives a perfect life so that we receive his perfection.

C: Fill me with your Spirit, O God, that my life and actions would be pleasing and acceptable to you.

P: In this holy season the Son of God enters into his Passion and death so that we are exalted.

C: Grant me your grace, O God, that my faith in Jesus would be pleasing and acceptable to you.

Imposition of Ashes "For dust you are and to dust you shall return"

After receiving the ashes, spend some time meditating on Psalm 90, found on page 258 in the front of your green hymnal.

Confession and Forgiveness

P: Having been reminded that we are dust, and to dust we shall return, let us confess our sins:

C: Most merciful God, we confess that our very nature is sinful. The root of our sin is pride, and pride has made us love ourselves more than we love you or others. Too often we believe that our lives are acceptable to you, when in reality they are not. We have sinned against you by speaking selfish words, by thinking selfish thoughts and by taking selfish action. Above all else, we have failed to love others and you more than ourselves. Have mercy on us sinners.

P: Since we cannot justify ourselves, our God sent his one and only Son to live a perfect life and die the death we deserved. Because of his generous grace, our sinful pride and all other sins are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Prayer of the Day - Almighty and ever-living God, you hate nothing you have made, and you forgive the sins of all who are penitent. Create in us new and honest hearts, so that, truly repenting of our sins, we may receive from you, the God of all mercy, full pardon and forgiveness through your Son, Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

For the LORD is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations. *(Psalm 100)*
